¹ Intermediate no. of years/no. of projects/no. of members will determine a score which will be calculated proportionally.

Eliminatory criteria

NGO's Declaration related to:

- Confirmation for achieved indicators in projects: y/n
- No fraud presumed/confirmed: y/n
- No termination of contracts and legal disputes from own fault, with different authorities/bodies: y/n

Evaluation criteria²:

For each evaluation criterion the applicant will mention the exact total duration/no. of projects.

For criterion no. 1 - the applicant shall make reference to and attach the relevant statutory documents.

Number of years in operation in the business environment (3 years): 1 point

Number of years in operation in the business environment (6 years): 2 points

Number of years in operation in the business environment (9 years): 3 points

Number of years in operation in the business environment (12 years): 4 points

Number of years in operation in the business environment (above 15 years): 5 points

For criterion no. 2 - the applicant shall mention, for each project: the title of the project, the start and end date, the main objective and activities, the name of the EU Fund and Programme, role of the applicant in the project, other details deemed necessary by the applicant.

Number of European funded projects (5 projects): 1 point

Number of European funded projects (10 projects): 2 points

Number of European funded projects (15 projects): 3 points

Number of European funded projects (20 projects): 4 points

Number of European funded projects (over 20 projects): 5 points

² Note: In case of applicants receiving the same total score, the winning applicant will be the one having more years of experience. If also the number of years of experience will be the same, then the winning applicant will be the one that implemented more EU funded projects. Finally, if the scoring is still equal, the actual number of members will prevail.

For criterion 3 - the applicant shall make reference to and attach the relevant documents

Number of members (10): 2 points

Number of members (15): 3 points

Number of members (20): 4 points

Number of members (over 25): 5 points
