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BACKGROUND

The Interreg VI-A Romania-Hungary Programme (ROHU Programme) is a territorial cooperation programme between two member states, Romania, and Hungary, funded through the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF), with a total allocation of 175,940,025.00 EUR (out of which 80% ERDF, in amount of 140,752,020.00 EUR). The Programme area (PA) is composed of 4 counties on the Romanian side and 4 counties (NUTS 3 political and administrative units) on the Hungarian side, as follows: Szabolcs-Szatmár-Bereg, Hajdú-Bihar, Békés, Csongrád-Csanád in Hungary; Satu Mare, Bihor, Arad, Timiș in Romania.

The vision for the ROHU Programme is a greener, more resilient, and cohesive cross-border region between Romania and Hungary, with an enhanced understanding of cooperation opportunities, increased trust, and reduced barriers to cooperation, towards Agenda 2030 common targets with a more sustainable cooperation framework.

The projects selected for financing under the ROHU Programme are analysed in relation to State Aid incidence, at the activity level, before being contracted. The general approach is to avoid such incidence, however, if this can not be eliminated, the Programme will handle relevant cases either under the de minimis Regulation¹, the General Block Exemption Regulation - GBER² and/or as Services of General Economic Interest - SGEI³.

PURPOSE

The purpose of procuring technical assistance services in the field of State aid is to provide specialised support to the Programme structures in the implementation and monitoring of projects contracted under the Interreg VI–A Romania–Hungary Programme, within the Specific Objectives relevant from the perspective of State aid incidence. Furthermore, should available ERDF funds be identified that would allow the financing of projects approved on the reserve lists corresponding to those Specific Objectives, the technical assistance services will also include support provided to the Managing Authority in analysing and classifying, in relation to the State aid incidence, the activities envisaged under those projects, in line with the options presented in the table above.

In this context, the Oradea Regional Office for Cross–Border Cooperation (BRECO), acting as Contracting Authority (CA), invites interested State aid service providers to submit their offers in accordance with the requirements set out below.

SERVICES TO BE PROVIDED

The main tasks of State Aid experts are:

- supporting the activity of the Joint Secretariat with regard to the implementation of projects under the relevant Specific Objectives, including but not limited to: opinions concerning amendments to subsidy contracts where activities involving State aid are concerned; issues related to the possible occurrence of indirect aid during project implementation; review of State

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aid-related documentation; State aid monitoring; relevant legislative amendments; and issues related to the recovery of aid;

- classifying the activities of selected projects from the perspective of State aid applicability (including requesting clarifications, where necessary, and completing the State aid assessment grids made available by BRECO), during the contracting stage of projects selected for funding from the reserve lists corresponding to the relevant Specific Objectives, based on the options available under the Programme, namely:
 - No State aid – including conditions for avoiding the applicability of State aid, where possible (full avoidance of State aid applicability would be preferable);
 - de minimis aid under Regulation (EU) 2023/2831⁵ (Order No. 1299/2024);
 - aid granted under Articles 20, 20a and 53 of Regulation (EU) No 651/2014⁶, as amended (Order No. 1201/2023);
 - Services of General Economic Interest (SGEI).

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

In carrying out the above-mentioned tasks, the services provider shall ensure at least 2 State Aid experts which must:

- have good knowledge of the Interreg VI-A Romania-Hungary Programme and the Applicant's Guide(s)⁷;
- know the content and structure of the application form;
- use the Jems and analyse the projects selected under State Aid-relevant Specific Objectives;
- ask for clarifications (through Joint Secretariat), if necessary;
- perform the State Aid incidence analysis and fill in the related State Aid Grid (to be provided by BRECO);
- comply with the deadlines established for the provision of the requested opinions / positions / recommendations and/or for carrying out the State aid incidence analysis;
- ensure the deliverance of high-quality outputs in due time.

SERVICES PROVIDER / STATE AID EXPERT PROFILE

State Aid experts should meet the following requirements:

- studies completed with a bachelor's degree, diploma or equivalent;
- advanced knowledge of English (C1/2 – experienced user according to the CV submitted);
- computer skills.

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The proposed experts must have the qualifications and professional experience to be able to successfully carry out all the activities indicated in this ToR.

The above criteria are cumulative and shall be proved by Europass format CV and other relevant documents, if the case.

Each State Aid expert shall submit, together with his/her/their CV, an Agreement for Processing of Personal Data (Annex 1 to this ToR).

The State Aid expert should also be aware of the provisions of the Declaration of Impartiality, Confidentiality and Avoidance of Conflict of Interest, which will have to be signed before starting the activity (Annex 2/Annex 2.1 to this ToR).

PROCUREMENT PROCESS

Type of procurement: direct procurement.

Tenders may be submitted by service providers authorized, in accordance with the relevant legislation (e.g. through the relevant CAEN code), to carry out such activities/services.

The offers (PDF format), consisting of technical offer, including CVs and relevant supporting documents (if the case), financial offer (fee per expert hour) and Annex 1 shall be submitted via email, by the **5th of June 2026, 16:00 CET/17:00 EET**, to the following e-mail address: **joint.secretariat@breacoradea.ro**. The services provider is requested to submit the offer including the fee per expert hour, in EUR, excluding VAT, for the above-mentioned services, taking into account that a maximum of 180 hours of specialized assistance services are expected to be provided until 31.12.2029. The estimated value of the requested services is of maximum EUR 62 net/expert hour. The contractual activities will be carried out at the Contracting Authority's request. Award criterion: the service contract will be concluded with the services provider who comes first in the evaluation of the offers submitted, as per the Offer evaluation grid (Annex 3 to this ToR), based on "best value for money" criterion.

The weighting of the technical offer evaluation factor is 70% and the weighting of the financial offer evaluation factor is 30%.

The result of the evaluation of the offers will be communicated via e-mail.

TERMS OF SERVICES CONTRACT

a. Contract

State Aid experts shall perform their tasks in the framework of the services procurement contract concluded with BRECO, as Joint Secretariat, under the Romanian legislation. The services contract will have **approximately 43 months duration, starting in June 2026 (indicatively) and ending no later than 31.12.2029.**

The services contract will specify the hourly expert fee, and the total final value of the contract will correspond to the final number of expert hours performed on the Contracting Authority's request and accepted by the Contracting Authority.

The services contract shall be concluded in euro (EUR)/ Romanian lei (RON), at the exchange rate of the European Commission applicable in the month the contract is concluded (the monthly

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exchange rates of the European Commission are published on:
https://commission.europa.eu/funding-tenders/procedures-guidelines-tenders/information-contractors-and-beneficiaries/exchange-rate-infoeuro_en).

These Terms of Reference shall be annexed to the services contract.

b. Location

The work shall be performed remotely, online.

The services provider will be responsible for ensuring from own resources all conditions necessary to perform the tasks in appropriate conditions.

c. Payment

The invoices for the performed and accepted services will be issued on a quarterly basis.

The payment shall be conditioned by the formal acceptance of the services provided, properly documented.

Important!

The requirements set out in these specifications are considered to be minimum requirements and economic operators are required to submit offers that meet the minimum requirements.

Any reference to a mark/matrix/manufacturer/origin/source/production/patent, etc. will be interpreted as meaning 'or equivalent' even where not expressly mentioned in the text.

Any qualification requirements, education/diplomas/licenses/certificates or technical specifications requested by this ToR shall be considered to be 'or equivalent'.

The points for the evaluation factor "Relevant experience in similar projects, where the proposed experts have carried out the same type of activities as those to be carried out in the future contract, in the context of national and/or European funded programs" will be awarded for each expert as follows:

- a) for the experience consisting in involvement in nationally funded programs - 30 points;
- b) for the experience consisting in involvement in European-funded programs - 50 points;
- c) for experience in involvement in Interreg programs - 70 points.

The score obtained by the provider for the criterion of experience in similar projects is calculated as the arithmetic average of the scores obtained by each proposed expert. The score can be a maximum of 70 points.

Project = a contract in which the expert has performed the same type of activities as those to be performed in the future contract.

Method of calculating the score of the offer

The price quoted in the tender is final, may not be increased and includes all the costs necessary for the performance of the contract.

The offer with the highest final score will be considered the winning offer.
